



Infrastructure

Campus is situated at 3rd mile stone from NH2, on Station Road, Shanti Nagar, Shikobabad, Firozabad (U.P.)

a) Building

Three storied school building comprises of modern classroom library, state of the art laboratories, high-tech computer lab, music & dance room and fully equipped communication infrastructure with camera monitoring.

b) Class Rooms

GDPS has spacious classes. Also they are ventilated and have natural light. The number of students in each class is restricted so that the teachers give individual attention to each student. Each classroom has a different colour scheme to create a good learning environment.

c) Computer Lab

Two of the laboratories cater to students learning C++ in classes XI and XII; one laboratory is dedicated to students of other classes for learning Oracle database programming; HTML and DHTML. A graded Computer Education programme exists in the school that introduces the use of computers at the Nursery level itself and then builds on the student's 'knowledge and skills' base at every subsequent level through CAL (Computer Aided Learning) and CLP (Computer Literacy Program).






d) Science Lab



Special Features



a) Day Boarding

The cognitive and psycho-motor skills of the tiny tots of kids Spring Blossom are developed by using a range of methods and techniques in a stress free, playful and fun oriented atmosphere without carrying the burden of homework. In the upper classes, the student completes the home work after school hours under the supervision of teachers.

b) Separate Hostel for Girls

Hostel facilities to the students coming from various districts and states. Architectural beauty, grassy lawns, open auditorium give an aesthetic view to the hostels. The students live under motherly care and in a homely environment. All the hostel rooms are spacious; boarders are provided with a bed, a cupboard, a book shelf, a study table & chair.

c) Career Counselling Deptt.

The school has a career - counselling Deptt. which helps students in choosing their career. The Deptt. provides information regarding Medical, Engineering, MBA, NDA etc. Students can get forms for entrance tests of different competitive exams. The Counsellors devote a lot of time to school - students not only to help them to overcome their personal problems but also to contribute to their personal development.

d) Library cum Reading Room

All the branches under our banner have a rich library where in books ranging from all time classics to contemporary blue ribbon books, ample reference books and support material for board and competitive exams are available for children. In order to keep the students abreast with the happenings round the world the library has, all the national dailies, periodicals and monthly magazines. To inculcate and ensure reading habit every class is assigned a library period.

e) Co-Curricular Activities

The school has a well balanced curriculum tuned to develop the mental and physical abilities of every child thus grooming him/her into an all round personality. Gyan Deep encourages activities like public speaking, debates, declamations, poetic recitation, poetry writing, dramatics, editing, adventure and hiking etc. It also promotes desirable creative activities and hobbies like music, dance, drawing, painting, fine arts and study of computers. f) House System

i) Computer Orientation Programme


India is going on for wide spread computerization and practically every field is going to be affected. Keeping this in mind computer education has been included in the school curriculum.

The school has a fleet of a very well-maintained buses to pick up students from homes to school and back. These are also used for students' tours, campus and excursions.



I) Courses offered at Senior Secondary Level

- (a) Science stream: Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Biology, English, Computer Science, Physical Edu., Painting & Hindi.
- b) Commerce stream: Business Studies, Accountancy, Economics, Maths, English, Hindi, Physical Edu., Painting, Computer Science & entrepreneurship.

m) Progress Reports and Promotion

Student's Diary should be checked daily by the parents so that they remain informed about day to day progress of their wards. A report of the performance of a student during the terms is communicated to his/her parents at the end of each term through progress reports. These reports contain the performance of the students in a academic, comments from the class teacher and the Principal. Promotion is granted on the basis of over all performance during the session and not on the basis of summative II or final examination results alone.

Admission

- The Registration will be opened for new session from March every year.
- The new academic session starts from April every year.
- Admission will be granted only after satisfactory performance in written testcum interview.
- If the parent/guardian decides not to send his ward to the school after the fee has been deposited, the above deposited fee will not be refunded in any case.
- Problematic students who do not improve after two warnings are rusticated and no readmission is accorded in any case.
- School is not responsible for any physical load to the student during playing, excursion, studying or caused due to negligence of the student. Although proper care and measures are taken by the school.
- At the time of admission date of birth certificate, mark sheet of previous class, school leaving certificate will be attached along with form.



Admission to Nursery

- Advertisement for the enrolment for Orientation Programme for Admission to Nursery is published in the newspapers in the month of September.
- Eligibility: Age should be between four and five years between or on September 30th of the academic session in which the child seeks admission to class nursery.
- 3) All the candidates and their parents are called for an interaction to assess the child using the following parameters:
 - Motor skills- Gross and fine.
 - Clarity of speech.
 - Emotional stability.
 - Interactivity.
 - Sociability.
- 4) Criteria for short listing:
 - Application form should be complete in all respects with the necessary documents (birth certificate, proof of residence) duly attested by a Gazetted Officer.
 - Clarity of speech.
 - Emotional stability.
 - Interactivity.
 - Sociability
- 5) Short listed candidates are forwarded to the selection committee for parent and child interaction. The committee comprises of Principal, Vice-Principal, Incharge Pre-Primary.





Admission from KG to IX


- Admissions are done strictly on the basis of number of seats available.
- A written assessment is conducted on the basis of the prescribed syllabus for the admission to particular class.
- Students who qualify the written test are called for an interaction.
- Admission is granted according to the Merit list prepared on basis of the performance of the student in the written test and the interaction.





Admission to XI

- Admissions are offered in two streams i.e. Science and Commerce.
- Admission in a particular stream is based on the cutoff percentage of marks in Class-X Board exam, as fixed by the school.
- 3) The list of the candidates who qualify according to the merit, is displayed in the month of June. Admission is granted to the successful candidates according to the school rules.



School uniform is of vital importance for the students. It encourages simplicity, group living, cleanliness, etiquette, feeling of equality and a sense of awareness among them. Whenever the students come to school they are supposed to be in the school uniform or the dress prescribed for the occasion.



THE HOSTEL (Only for girls)

Rules for the Boarders (Hostellers)

All instructions regarding hostel rules are given in detail to the students and they are to abide by the same strictly.


- Hostel charges are to be deposited in advance as per schedule given.
- 2) Student's school fee will be drawn from the personal account every month/quarter. Late fee at the rate of Rs. 10/- per day will be charged if dues are not deposited in time.
- 3) All personal expenses incurred on the child regarding books, stationery, dress, medicines, school fee, examination fee etc. along with the pocket expenses will be debited to personal money account. Quarterly statement of this account will be sent to the parents.



- Educational tour is compulsory for all boarders. The expense of which will be debited to the personal account.
- 5) Guardians/parents may come to meet their wards only with the permission of the Principal on Sundays & Holidays. Parents should avoid too frequent visits. Parent's visits are not permitted up to one month after admission.

- Parents are supposed to take their children from the school at the time of long vacation.
- 7) Hostel charges include lodging & boarding with two nourishing vegetarian meals, breakfast, evening snacks and lemonade, milk at night or in breakfast. It may varies or changes.
- 8) Free tuition facility is provided to boarders.
- A minimum balance of Rs. 1000/- is to be maintained in the personal account of the child.
- 10) If a child is withdrawn from the hostel or is expelled on account of some default, no deposited money except security and personal balance will be refunded. Refundable amount will only be paid in the last month of the year i.e. March.
- 11) Home leave to the boarders is granted in very rare cases and that too only by the Principal. The guardian must come personally to take the child from the hostel. The child won't be allowed to go home without escort. But during examination period the child may not be permitted to leave hostel in any case.



- 12) School will not be responsible for students who go out of the school without permission of the Warden/Principal. This action of the student will be considered as violation of hostel rule and will result in expulsion from the hostel.
- 13) Electronic gadgets, mobile phones, cards, magazines or any expensive items are not allowed to be kept in the hostel. The school reserves the right to confiscate the item and even destroy it.
- 14) Hostel fee deposited will not be refunded in any case, even if child does not stay in hostel for a single day.

Rules for School Bus Commuters

- The buses will pick up the students from the (allotted) bus stops and drop them after the school hours at the stops.
- 2) The buses will not wait for the late comers. The commuters are expected to be at the their stops 10 minutes before the scheduled time.
- The children should stay peacefully and away from the main road till the bus arrives.
- 4) Students will be held responsible for any damage caused to the bus due to their negligence.
- Students availing bus facility will deposit their bus charges in advance along with other school charges and fee.





- 6) Bus charges are to be paid for one calender year of the session (12 months) along with school fee.
- Students can not withdraw their manes from the bus facility in the month of May, February & march.
- 8) If a student after discontinuing this facility wants to re-enroll it after some time during the same academic year, he will have to make payment for the gap period.
- If student wants to discontinue the bus facility, he will have to deposit one month extra charge or seek permission one month in advance.
- 10) Parents are requested to refrain from breaking into any argument with any staff on bus route. In case of any grievance regarding bus service or behaviour of any staff should be made to the transport in charge.

The school dispensary


The school dispensary consists of a qualified & experienced resident doctor assisted by a nurse & an attendant. Cases of minor ailments are cared for in the school dispensary.

- For withdrawal of a child one week notice is essential. A surplus charge to be paid for SLC along with all the dues against the child.
- Board examination fee will be prescribed by the C.B.S.E. board from time to time.


